| AGES 2 - 5 <i>Little Hands to Heaven</i> | Overview of Biblical history using Bible stories in chronological order from creation to Paul's missionary journeys | A first look at science through weekly activities related to the Bible Stories |
| AGES 5 - 7 <i>Little Hearts for His Glory</i> | Chronological overview of history from Bible times to present day; main emphasis is on Biblical and American history | General science introduction: Twice weekly experiments with text connections related to history stories |
| AGES 6 - 8 <i>Beyond Little Hearts for His Glory</i> | Chronological early American history focus from 1565-1865 told in story form; includes weekly geography lessons | General science overview: Using twice weekly experiments with text connections related to the history stories |
| AGES 7 - 9 <i>Bigger Hearts for His Glory</i> (extending to grades 4-5) | Biographical approach to American history from the 1500's – 1970's; includes weekly geography lessons | Life, Physical, and Earth Science Focus: Daily readings and assignment are from living books and biographies. Life, physical, and earth science are emphasized. Readings loosely coordinate with the history study |
| AGES 8 - 10 <i>Preparing Hearts for His Glory</i> (extending to grades 5-6) | One-year chronological overview of world history told in narrative form; Biblical history is intertwined with the rest of world history. Weekly geography work with maps and globes is included | Life, Physical, and Earth Science Focus: Daily independent readings and activities are scheduled for students using living books. Life, earth, and physical science are explored. Readings loosely coordinate with history study |
